and you would still be violating the law from the person selling to someone with a fake ID, but I think that the book provides a defense to that that should be kept on the records. I do have some ideas. Everyone has said, you know, they don't know why we should go to "may". I think there's some...there's a very easy answer to that.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Then I'll listen to your discussion.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. Pres...oh, I have a minute. Well, Mr. Speaker and members of the Legislature, I'm going to listen with an open mind to what Senator Hilgert tells me, but thus far his arguments have not been persuasive. The assertions of Senator Janssen have done more to turn me against this bill, and the fact that "Baron" Tyson was going to speak, then the liquor lobby scared him off makes me even more skeptical of this amendment. He's gone. Oh, here he is. (Laughing) I'm going to see if he's going to contribute anything to the discussion. Notice, I didn't say anything meaningful or worthwhile, just anything. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Baker.

SENATOR BAKER: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the body. I will try to put a practical perspective on this. When a clerk has a line of people there, six or eight long, and he checks someone who is 26-years-old or whatever, you don't want to have to take the time to fill the book out. You can if you want, but you don't want to do that as a rule. You have people standing in line and I know our clerks check people who are 26-, 28-years old. You can't always tell how old they are by appearance, and it seems a waste of time to have to enter those into the book. Anyone who is borderline, certainly, we're going to put them in; 22-, 23-, 24-years-old, yes, we'll use the book, but it's an option. And I would guess even though this bill, or amendment would be adopted, they're...most retailers are going to require their clerks to do it anyway, I would think. But there are cases when you do check someone who is way past the age of 21 and you don't want to take the time. For those who have them fill it out, it takes a few, a couple of three minutes anyway to
