So I would oppose the bill and I think it's very appropriate to have suggestions in here because I'm not...I'm don't think it's talking about the absolute that we have to follow in order to get a permit, but only suggestions on how to get there. Thank you.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Senator Preister, you're recognized to speak to the Beutler amendment.

SENATOR PREISTER: Thank you, Honorable President. I rise in support of the amendment and find that it is an interesting interpretation. In the committee, I raised the same issue, and without discussing it with Senator Beutler, he identified the same interpretation as I had with the committee. Basically, what his amendment does is strike one word that's new language that's been added to existing statute. That word is "suggested", and so when you insert "suggested" after best management practices, it takes out any real authority. It takes out any real responsibility. It simply says this is a suggestion. I would suggest to you that we drop the "suggested" and that if there is an interest in, and I think there's a legitimate concern that Senator Bromm was talking about yesterday, in having the opportunity available for using experimental or unproven practices. But if that's the goal, if that's really what folks want to have here, then let's say that. Let's not say "suggested" which is subject to various interpretations and, obviously, we've got at least two opinions of that here on the floor right now. If we need to do something else, then let's look at that language that we really want to say and say that. Let's not leave "suggested" in there and then leave the ambiguity and the differing interpretations that we've already come up with and that we're dealing with right now. As I read "suggested", it says this is an offer, this is a guide, this is something you may want to do. In the case of Senator Kremer, you can suggest how somebody gets to a different location from where they are, and there are many routes. Well, in best management practices, there may be many routes also. However, we have a regulatory body whose charge and responsibility is to provide those proven already utilized best management practices. That's what this is. This is a
