He wants no part of it. He's just like Peter. "I don't know this man." Well, you're a member of the Legislature. "But I'm not a part of what they're doing." Well, I've heard you speak on the floor before. "I've got nothing to do with it." Then you hear "cock-a-doodle-doo". Three times you deny, then the cock crows. Mr. President, I'm going to ask for a call of the house, and I want a roll call vote on this bill...on this amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The question is, shall the house go under call? Those in favor vote aye; those opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 8 ayes, 0 nays to place the house under call, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The house is under call. Would unauthorized personnel please leave the floor? Would all unexcused members please return to the Chamber and record your presence?
