SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes, I will be brief. I will just explain that this amendment is to the main appropriations bill for \$25,000 a year for the Nebraska Volunteer Service Commission. It is a third of the amount that was in the original bill. It completely does away with the...I mean it completely does away with the provisions of the bill which called for codification. All they're asking for is this basic dollar amount so they can stay in business, and my staff did tell me, Senator Hudkins, that most of this probably would go to administration just to keep them going. So I think I was fairly correct in what I said to you. So thank you very much.
