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SENATOR SCHMITT: No, that's fine. But I agree with that. I'm not opposed to the training. I think it is very necessary. And I agree with you, I don't believe the one at the training center at Grand Island is equipped for the large bore rifle, but I do believe that they do fire the big rifle out at the ordnance plant where they have a range out there. And so I guess that was a question I had, has this really been looked into to whether we know whether this is the most efficient way to go or whether we could do something else and save a lot of dollars. That's my question I guess. So you can have the rest of my time, if you want to continue.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: If...how many...how much time do I have? I will use his and not any more of my time.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: About a minute and 20 seconds.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Okay, that's enough for me for now. I...these are reasonable questions and I assume some of these should have been raised maybe two years ago. I...September '97 it shows up, 950,000, it's a line in the program, so it's not new. I wasn't prepared to answer all the questions today on this training range except to say, once again, we have a safety issue that's increasing every week, if not every day, in southwest Lincoln. We know we need the time. Now, whether we can build a 500 thousand dollar range instead of a 950, I can't answer that question today, but I think if you listen to what Senator Tyson said, what they have in their range, and I assume it's outdoor, and so it...it takes a significant amount of range. I guess there are several "Big Red One" graduates in here, Senator Pedersen. I served in the "Big Red One" too and went through many of those training things. I don't know about the one in the United States. I never was in that sharpshooter unit. But the point is we need the training. If there's a way to cut corners here, I guess I can't answer all those questions here tonight. I assume that if that...if there's a way to cut corners that certainly Corrections would have looked into that because, if you recall, the big picture is what we...
