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be the third one and, as I understand it, if I've got my facts correct here, not only would Corrections use it but I think the State Patrol, I think I was told the State Patrol would probably use it, and the university police have traditionally used the facility that we have here in Lincoln, and U.S. Marshals, Senator Wehrbein says. So that might give you some idea of what's out there and what facilities there are. I'm going to...I am not going to support the Pedersen amendment. I am going to support the facility in Tecumseh. I guess I would be willing to listen to the cost of it and the extent of it, but apparently, from the little I know, and it is little at this point, it is a necessary facility. In addition, I want that shooting range out of...it's either my district or Byars' district, I'm not quite sure where that shooting range is, but I have been convinced that it's a dangerous situation out there and, as more development and more people are near that range, it gets to be more and more of a problem. So it does need to be moved from there. So, for those two reasons mainly, I am not going to support the Pedersen amendment. I'm sorry, Dwite. (Laugh)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Schimek. Senator Wehrbein, your light is on next, but you've used your three times on this amendment. Senator Hilgert.

SENATOR HILGERT: Thank you. No, Senator Smith, I'm not going to call the question, but I think that's probably coming fairly quickly. I have a couple of questions. I understand there's going to be 450 employees with this prison and if we were going to have 450 employees that were all cross-trained regarding small arms fire as well as these high-power sniper rifles, a three-hour drive would be prohibitive and inefficient, I would agree with that. But my question, Senator Wehrbein, is every one of the personnel going to be trained as one of these rifle carrying people?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: You know, I can't answer that question. I can find out for you soon.

SENATOR HILGERT: Okay.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I would guess a majority would be, but I'll
