PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: One minute.

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: ...and cost effective, take that into consideration. But there's some other things here. Vote as your heart tells you to and I hope that I've been able to bring at least some education to the body. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Pedersen. Question is the adoption of Amendment 1634 to LB 878. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed nay. Senator Pedersen.

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: I'd like to have a call of the house, please.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The question is, shall the house go under call? Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 17 ayes, 1 nay to place the house under call.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The house is under call. Senator Pedersen.

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: I'd accept call-in votes.
