LB 663, 664

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Wehrbein's amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is agreed to.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Senator Smith.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 663 to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The question is the advancement of LB 663 to E & R. Those in favor say aye; those opposed nay. The ayes have it.

CLERK: Senator Smith, with respect to LB 664, E & Rs, first of all. (AM7134. See page 7194 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB 664.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The question is the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 664. Those in favor say aye; those opposed nay. The amendments are agreed to.

CLERK: Senator Wehrbein would move to amend with AM1572. (See page 1803 of the Legislative Journal.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Wehrbein, you're recognized to open on Amendment 1572.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Thank you, Mr. President. This is much the same as LB 6...the amendment to LB 663. It identifies the proper fund source for the State Building Fund and identifies a specific budget program number. Once again, the State Building Fund is actually General Funds. General Funds becomes State Building Fund. Relatively, a technical amendment.
