SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Congratulations. We next move to legislative confirmation reports, the Health and Human Services Committee. The Chair, Senator Jensen, you're recognized to open on the confirmation reports.

SENATOR JENSEN: Thank you, Mr. President, Mr. Speaker, and members of the body. The Health and Human Services Committee wants to report favorably on the appointments of the following individuals: Dr. Glenn York, State Board of Health; Maria Ragan, Health and Human Services System Partnership Council; Jim Blue, Health and Human Services System Partnership Council; Lend Frison, Health and Human Services System Partnership Council; Alice Maupin, Health and Human Services System Partnership Council; William Heine, Board of Emergency Medical Services; and Brent Welsch, Commission for the Deaf and Hard of Hearing. These individuals and their resumes were before the committee a week ago and we have reported favorably upon them and place those names before you for confirmation. Thank you, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Senator Jensen. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman and members of the Legislature, I've given the Clerk a division that I would like to make in the names. There will be two votes taken.
