SENATOR LYNCH: Mr. President, members, I failed to do something that was most important. Seriously, I forgot to thank Senator Jensen, as Chairman of the committee, and the committee itself for allowing this important amendment that I introduced to be part of what Senator Jensen is offering now as well. Senator Jensen and the committee, I think, understood the importance of this and was willing to help with this particular amendment. And I didn't say thank you, as I should have publicly to him and the committee, so hopefully I make up for that now.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you for that, Senator Lynch. Seeing no lights, Senator Jensen, you wish to close on your amendment? Senator Jensen waives closing. The question before the body is, shall the Jensen amendment, AM1486, be adopted to LB 594A? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 41 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Jensen's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 594A to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Question before the body is advancement of LB 594A to E & R for engrossing. All those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced. Items for the record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Thank you, Mr. President. An amendment to be printed to LR 5CA by Senator Kristensen. Study resolutions. (Read LR 102-107 by title for the first time.) Those will all be referred to the board. (Legislative Journal pages 1881-1884.)

Mr. President, with respect to LB 44, no E & R's. I do have an amendment to the bill. First of all, Senator Chambers, I have
