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SENATOR CHAMBERS: Generally speaking, that's correct what you're saying.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Okay. I was interested in that mechanism. So apparently some of the decision process at this level is made, if it's a sizeable haul or a less haul, they'll decide which statute to use, federal or state, federal court or state court, I assume, if it has to do with evidence and realistic convictions and all those kinds of things. And I assume by this afternoon's discussion some implication as to the size of the potential fine or money coming back, I don't want to make...I won't make that allegation necessarily, but I assume that that may enter into it. I was kind of interested in mechanics and...but I did want to talk about the book. There is some oversight, at least as I understand, some of the money coming back from the feds. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. Senator Chambers, on FA190.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, engaging in the futile research that I often engage in around here, I had handed out a packet of information to all of the senators on April the 21st dealing with this subject. I included a copy of the constitutional provision, every statute that was implicated. Some of those that were involved were...dealt with what Senator Wehrbein is talking about--this tax that those who are dealing in illegal marijuana have to pay. That has nothing whatsoever to do with what I'm talking about here. That tax on marijuana has nothing whatsoever to do with what we're talking about here. We're talking about people who are stopped and charged. But what seems to be going by some of my colleagues is the fact that when it's in the federal system, if they decide to take that approach, they don't have to charge the person with a crime. Let's say that a person is going from here to California. Well, let me give an example that "60 Minutes" had. This person was going from Florida to New York or one of the northeastern states to buy some exotic trees. He had a nursery. He had gone up there with his flatbed truck and had this money that he was going to make the purchase with. He had all the paperwork. He was stopped on the way there. Because he
