first part of the amendment. Let's have the study, let's get some more facts. Let's come back with a bill which will be referenced to the Judiciary Committee. Let's let the people come in and answer questions and present their testimony.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: One minute.

SENATOR BROMM: Let's reflect on the federal law as...as it interrelates to the state law and the state constitution. We can't ignore the federal law unless we want to adopt this amendment, which says that we really won't participate with the federal government in these drug investigations. If we want not to do that, then that is the effect of adopting the underlying Chambers amendment. So I urge you to...I'm not saying that I want my amendment, but I'm urging you to think about the effect of the underlying amendment and I hope that I have helped you think about that by offering this amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Bromm. Senator Bohlke, on FA192 to FA190.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Thank you, Mr. President. This really is just with regard to something I said on the floor. When I was referring to schools and how this impacted schools, I mistakenly said "nonequalized schools". I meant "equalized schools". And I see that Senator Schimek said she caught that. That means that you all really are understanding the state aid formula and I appreciate that, but I did want to have it correct on the record. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Bohlke. Senator Tyson.

SENATOR TYSON: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. I rise actually seeking information. Looking at Article VII, at Section 5, and paragraph (2), which reads: "Fifty percent of all monies forfeited or seized pursuant to the enforcement of the drug laws shall belong and be paid over to the counties for drug enforcement purposes as the Legislature may provide." So I ask a question at large, perhaps Senator Bromm, if he is available, why, if the drug money doesn't lose its character as it proceeds into this chain,...
