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SENATOR THOMPSON: ...only.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Okay.

SENATOR THOMPSON: So, actually, the question that's being asked of me about planning and so forth, that was all done by the Office of Juvenile Services in collaboration with the Department of Correctional Services. They did that together. A decision was made two years ago to just have that facility for the adult system only. So we have, as a state, have planned for a juvenile facility. We have blueprints. We have all of that.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Is there room in this for...is this facility in Omaha to capacity, do you know, is it?

SENATOR THOMPSON: That's my understanding. It was built so you could double the size. One of the questions that Senator Beutler had, that facility has cafeteria service areas and so forth that is enough to double the housing area for it.

SENATOR HARTNETT: And, Senator Thompson, and then the report of the Nebraska Juvenile Justice Task Force, who did you report...who did that go to?

SENATOR THOMPSON: It went to the Governor and the Legislature.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Went to Appropriations?

SENATOR THOMPSON: Well, it went to every member of the Legislature.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Oh, not a specific committee or anything like that.

SENATOR THOMPSON: No, it went...we did...we held a press conference and kind of did a public aspect. We presented information. Part of the task force met with the Governor and we went over it and all copies were given to all members of the Legislature around the...

SENATOR HARTNETT: Then you introduced...
