that's...the reason I bring it isn't to go get back at anybody. It's to try to protect the process here. And it is necessary now, it's real necessary. Because if you don't do it now, when are you going to do it? You going to let one of these constitutional amendments easily get passed and all of a sudden four months later everybody says, well, I didn't know that's where all the money got contributed; I didn't know who that...who was behind that. It's too late then. Last fall, that should have been a wake up for you, it really should. And I, perhaps, sound a little preachy because I probably care too much about this issue that the constitution is up for sale, but it really is. And this is one way, without infringing on people's rights, to slow the process down and I'd hope that you'd do that.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Time. Senator Wehrbein, followed by Senators Schrock, Smith, Tyson, Quandahl.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Thank you, Mr. President, members. I start out by saying I'm strong leaning towards support of this, although I did want to hear the debate. Because when I first heard the idea that I think Senator Kristensen had, I thought it was a good idea then and I have come to (inaudible). I do believe, is that right, Senator Christian (sic), other states...there's some other states have a double election on this, if I...

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: They have...they have...it has to be approved twice. You know, some states, to change the constitution, you have to do it in the house and in the senate. Some states require that both bodies do it twice. Nobody's got our unique system and I'm not aware, and I'm looking at Senator Schimek, I don't believe there's another state that does two votes to do it of the electorate.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Okay. Somewhere I thought I read there was, but I don't know either.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Yeah.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: But that does...the unicameral system does make it unique in Nebraska because many...those that would
