SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I had was from Senator Tyson, but I have a note, he wants to withdraw at this time as well.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Senator Bromm had an amendment, Mr. President, AM1335, but likewise would like to withdraw it at this time.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Schrock and Beutler, AM1649. (Legislative Journal page 1873.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator...Senator Schrock, did you wish to open?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Senator Beutler was going to open on that.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Beutler, open on your amendment.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Members of the Legislature, this amendment will be introduced to you, just briefly. We did make one change to accommodate Senator Connealy and some of the tire interests that are interested in this particular bill. So I think for the moment what we will do, if Senator Schrock is agreeable, is to withdraw this amendment, allow Senator Hilgert to go with his last amendment, and then we'll...we'll refile it and I'll introduce...and we will introduce this amendment to you. So, if that's agreeable with Senator Schrock, I would withdraw the amendment for the moment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk, next amendment.

CLERK: Senator Hilgert would move to amend, Mr. President. (AM1686, Legislative Journal page 1916.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Hilgert, to open on your amendment.
