discussion with Game and Parks as to why they have something in rules and regs that they don't use, and, as I understand, get a little more information from Game and Parks as to what they would like to see in education courses and further that discussion. I think those...those kinds of discussions could then take place before Select. I think it's better to take this out on General File and come back when we have that type of information that will help us, I think, make sure that we are doing something that will not cause any further lawsuits, but meet the concerns of Game and Parks and get some answers from Game and Park...Games and Park as to why things are in rules and regs now and are never used. And so, with that, I support the reconsider motion.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Bohlke. Senator Schrock, on the reconsider motion.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, there is some confusion going on here, and I don't pretend to understand all of it, but I think it's prudent that we advance this bill today and address these concerns on Select File. Now, it doesn't matter to me whether we pull the motion to reconsider, or whether we reconsider and pull the amendment, either way I think we can fix this on Select File. But I do think it's important to advance the bill today, give us a chance to do some research. And I'd certainly defer to Senator Hilgert and Senator Peterson, whatever is agreeable amongst the two of them certainly is agreeable to me at this time. And we will try and obtain some information and try and get some answers from Game and Parks. I know in the past there's been some pretty strict regulations on how close you can be to a dock with a motorboat and it isn't always enforced, nor can it be enforced. There's just not enough wardens out there to do the enforcement. And certainly on private lakes, where the lakes are smaller, it becomes a concern. So I'll defer to Senator Hilgert and Senator Peterson, whatever they decide to do. But I will pledge to them that we will try and fix the situation on...on...on Select File, but I think it's important that we move the...move the main thrust of the bill forward today, and I hope that that's what the body will agree to. So I'll defer to Senator Hilgert and Senator Peterson, whatever they decide to do on this amendment.
