

TRANSCRIPT PREPARED BY THE CLERK OF THE LEGISLATURE
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LB 176

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schrock. There are no further lights. Senator Peterson, did you wish to close on your reconsider motion?

SENATOR C. PETERSON: Yes, thank you, Senator Cudaback. Members of the body, I visited with Senator Hilgert, he's visited with the Game and Parks, and they are all right, if we do reconsider the motion and vote against the amendment, and then we will work on it between now and Select File so that there will be the issues brought up. I think Senator Bohlke made a good point, as Senator Smith did, there is some confusion out there, and I think it would help to clarify that. But I think as Senator Bromm and Senator Bohlke also said, the best way is to reconsider this, strike the amendment and go forward from there. And I will give the rest of my time to Senator Hilgert.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Hilgert.

SENATOR HILGERT: This was, I think, the 47th priority, personal priority that was declared. And it has...it's the 77th day of the session, but...so it's been around for a while, but it's interesting how much input one receives on their priority bill the morning that it is to come up. I would agree for the motion to reconsider. Let's strike the amend...the Hilgert amendment, 1686, then hopefully we can advance to Select File. And I pledge on the record to work with Senator Peterson and interested parties so that on Select File we may have a very clear direction of what the issues are, what they do, and where we're going to go. And thank you, Senator Peterson, for yielding time. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Hilgert. The question before the body is the reconsider motion on the amendment that was adopted to LB 176. All in favor to reconsider vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, to reconsider the vote. Senator Hilgert, I have AM1686 pending at this time.

SENATOR HILGERT: I would like to vote red.
