SENATOR BEUTLER: Some are being done but we don't know exactly which ones are being done. Are there...are there any...

SENATOR BROWN: Well,...

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...of these that are not...that are not current allowed under Nebraska law for Nebraska housing authorities?

SENATOR BROWN: In the way that it's allowed under LB 105, they are not allowed under current law in the way that it's set out in LB 105.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay, so we're changing current law with regard to all five of these items in one form or another and to some degree or another. Is that...is that...

SENATOR BROWN: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...accurate?

SENATOR BROWN: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: How...how can I discover to what extent and in what ways we're changing each one of these five? I guess one of the problems I'm having in just looking at this a hundred and some page amendment is...is that I'm too ignorant of current law and I have no way...

SENATOR BROWN: Well,...

SENATOR BROWN: It is difficult and current law is antiquated and that's why the committee has spent three years trying to deal with this legislation because the model legislation was so broad and our current legislation was so old that finding some
