SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. Well, I would yield...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...the rest of my time to Senator Hartnett for further explanation of his disagreement.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You have less than one minute, Senator Hartnett.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I perhaps, Senator, didn't appropriately characterize it.

SENATOR HARTNETT: I guess my objection is that if you look at the committee statement that the people that were opposed to this bill were...come from the real estate industry. And I guess I thought that there should be some way at the local level that the real estate people and other people involved in the housing industry can protest, I guess, at a public hearing what is going on with the housing authority. And there has to be a public hearing for any of their projects. Later on I, you know, found out maybe...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR HARTNETT: ...the three years is...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Hartnett. Senator Schimek, followed by Senator Hartnett and Senator Brown to part two of the Brown amendment to the committee amendments to LB 105. Senator Schimek.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes, thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. Senator Beutler, did you wish to pursue your questioning? Because I would yield my time to you if you do.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Thank you very much Senator. What I'm trying to figure out here is if we reject...if we reject this portion, we've already deleted Section 77, have we not?
