SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Wickersham. (Visitors introduced.) Senator Beutler, on part one of the Brown amendment. Senator Beutler waives. Senator Brown, there are no further lights. Do you wish to close on part one of your amendment to the committee amendments to LB 105?

SENATOR BROWN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, we do have a lot of issues around the tax-exempt status. And I do believe that there are some issues in my amendment that need to be clarified. And so I think that at this point I would urge you to defeat this portion of the amendments...of my amendments, and then we will continue to work on the tax-exempt language as we work on the committee amendments. And we can bring forward some other ideas. So, at this point, I would urge you to defeat this division of the committee amendments.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Brown. The question before the body is, shall part one of the Brown amendment to the committee amendments to LB 105 be adopted? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 0 ayes, 21 nays, Mr. President, on that component of the amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Part one of the Brown amendment is not adopted. Mr. Clerk, items for the record?

CLERK: Mr. President, thank you. Amendments by Senator Wehrbein to LB 594A; Senator Crosby, LB 119A; Senator Dierks, LB 835A. Two study resolutions by Senator Janssen (re LR 121 and LR 122), both will be referred to the board. (Legislative Journal pages 1950-1952.)

Mr. President, the next amendment, Senator Smith. But I understand, Senator, that...well, the amendment I have is AM1648, but I have a note you want to withdraw AM1648, Senator?

SENATOR SMITH: And substitute AM1687.
