CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal pages 1957-1958.) 26 ayes, 12 nays.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is agreed to. The call is raised. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Tyson, do you still want to defer your amendment till Select File? I have nothing further to the committee amendments, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Discussion on the committee amendments to LB 105? Senator Hartnett, you're recognized to close on the committee amendments.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Mr. Vice (sic) President, members of the body, we just changed the income eligibility from hundred...and 125 percent to 100 percent with that last amendment. We did tighten up the tax exemption to fit in more with LB 271 and we did change the reviewing process of government review. I wanted to do a different way Senator Brown wanted to, and that's basically what it is, and it's operative of January 1, 2000. So I'd ask for the advancement of...or approval of the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Hartnett. The question is the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 105. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Voting on the adoption of the committee amendments. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: 40 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of committee amendments.
