subsequent offenses, makes it possible on the third and subsequent offenses, and instead of measuring offenses within a four-year period, it measures those offenses in a three-year period. I offer it, as I've indicated several times simply because I think it is fair and reasonable and still provides the enforcement that we all want to take place. I urge the adoption of the amendment. I thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Brashear. You've heard the closing. The question is the adoption of the Brashear amendment to LB 267. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. We're voting on the Brashear amendment, have you all voted? Senator Brashear.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Madam Chair, I'd request a call of the house, please.

SENATOR CROSBY: A request for a call of the house. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. A roll call vote has been requested. Record, please.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays to place the house under call.

SENATOR CROSBY: The house is under call. Would all senators please record your presence. Would those unexcused senators please return to the Chamber and record your presence. Would all unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. The house is under call. Senator Lynch, the house is under call. Senator Brashear.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Madam Chair, please proceed. Thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. A roll call vote has been requested. We are voting on the Brashear amendment to LB 267. Mr. Clerk, please. I understand that, that you asked for the roll call. Is it all right with you, Senator Chambers, to go ahead since we're missing...? Thank you, Senator Chambers. We appreciate that. Mr. Clerk, would you please call the roll.
