Arlington, Virginia, served from 1971 to 1974. Senator Willard Waldo, from DeWitt; Senator Waldo served from 1957 to 1959, then again from '61 to '63, and finally from 1968 through 1973. Senator John Weihing, from Gering; Senator Weihing served from 1987 to 1991. Senator Wayne Ziebarth, from Wilcox; Senator Ziebarth served from 1969 to 1973.

I believe that's everyone who's here. If I've missed anyone, I hope someone will let me know. Now there's a few that are probably former senators who are now senators, so I don't know what to do with Senator Byars and Senator Beutler. I assume you haven't paid your dues, you two, so you don't count. (Laughter.) And, Senator Schrock, I guess I'd count you as a senator and former senator, however that works.

Ladies and gentlemen, we're very proud to have you back in the Chamber. Your service has helped us tremendously and we want to show our appreciation at this point in time. (Applause.) As we close this afternoon, I understand there is a chance for some fellowship. The current members of the Legislature, there's a little bit of work left to do, and we're going to stay and probably do that. But, if we could throw one last plug in, you're the individuals who know the benefits of the unicameral system; you're the people who know the benefits of service. There might be a little senator's pay raise coming out in the future, we'd hope that you'd support that. (Laughter.) Thank you for being here today.
