SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schmitt. Senator Chambers, on the Kiel amendment.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Kiel, I would like to ask you a question.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Kiel, would you respond to a question?

SENATOR KIEL: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Suppose, and I would have to draft this correctly to be sure I've got it in the right place of your amendment, on page 4, in line 1, we would up that fee from \$10 to \$250, like the dealer plates?
