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hearing it, instead of merely uttering it, it has much greater impact on me. And were I not persuaded, what you read would have persuaded me. The people are the ones given the right to circulate these petitions, and they can put anything in those petitions they want to, anything. They can draft it anyway they want to. Do you think the Secretary of State is going to read that businesspeople's petition with all the obvious errors in it, and have the gall to say, this cannot go on the ballot? The Secretary of State is going to stand up to the business powers throughout this state? No! The Secretary of State would say, it goes on the ballot, then the other side could challenge it. This is creating a political football. If none of the issues involved were political, maybe the issues that I'm raising would not be as pertinent, but I do not want any official of this state correcting these petitions. But beyond that, what is the Secretary of State going to have to go through to determine whether or not it violates the U.S. Constitution, whether it violates the U.S. laws? Is the Secretary of State going to know all aspects of the constitution that are implicated by the petition? Is that what you want to convert the Secretary of State into, a legal research bureau? And then any law, any U.S. law, suppose somebody said it implicates the commerce clause, because we don't know what these crazy people are going to be trying to do with these petitions. And somebody else might say, well, it involves the supremacy clause of the United States, as some of those term limit things did. So he would then say, well, maybe you got a point there. Then somebody else would start writing legal memoranda to the Secretary of State and say, you be sure and you look at these things, because these parts of the Constitution and these federal laws are involved. And if you don't deal with them, then I'm going to use this against you to show that you are biased in favor of or prejudiced against. And we create a brand new area for political dispute. If I were circulating a petition, maybe I would like nothing better than to have a political dispute such as this generated, because it costs me no money, and maybe I don't have a lot of money. But I can certainly keep the pot boiling, and then I can make press releases and I could have the media running to me, because they like cheap, sensational stories, and I'd know how to sensationalize. I'd know the kind of comments to make. I could turn a phrase. And then we'd get away...
