bracket it. Obviously, a member can object to anything that is offered by way of a priority motion. I'm going to support Senator Schimek's motion to bracket. In fact, if this were the convention bill and...such luck...a motion had been made to bracket it until January 1 of next year, I wouldn't try to stop that motion because I'd rather have the bill dead...that is, if Senator Lynch, the introducer, made the motion. If anybody whose bill it is made a motion such as that, I would agree with it. But when it comes to something like this, I will grant, to the extent that I can, the request of the member whose bill it is. So I am supporting Senator Schimek's motion to bracket.
