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LB 271

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Okay, and you actually lease something in this 75 foot strip that is required to be there by some governing body.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Yes.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: And you think that the 75 foot is a public purpose.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Yes.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Okay, the structure of 271 looks beyond that and says is the use in the hands of the tenant a public use? And if it is not, then that is subject to taxation. So the answer would be that not only the building but the underlying land would have a value and that would be subject to tax.

SENATOR BOHLKE: As well as the 75 foot strip.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Well, you're in the 75 foot strip, whatever portion of the 75 foot strip you own or lease.

SENATOR BOHLKE: All right. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Bohlke. Seeing no further lights, the question before the body is shall LB 271 be advanced to E & R for engrossing? All those...

SENATOR MATZKE: Machine vote.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Matzke, there's been a request for a machine vote. All those in favor of LB 271 being advanced to E & R for engrossing vote aye, opposed nay. We are voting on the advancement of LB 271 to E & R for engrossing. Have you all voted? Have you all voted that care to? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 6 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 271.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 271 is advanced to E & R for engrossing.
