SENATOR HARTNETT: Yeah, that will be done in the future.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Okay.

SENATOR HARTNETT: It's not...it's not done now.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Okay.

SENATOR HARTNETT: But I think there are some guidelines, that's what seems to be that other...I think about 39 states have adopted some type of a program like this,....

SENATOR VRTISKA: Okay.

SENATOR HARTNETT: ...and that's what they use.

SENATOR VRTISKA: And...

SENATOR HARTNETT: And I think going to school and doing some other...I think there are some others...

SENATOR VRTISKA: You have to do those things.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Yeah, they have to do those things, but I think that will add to the point system.

SENATOR VRTISKA: And it will be \$100 a year per fireman that you become eligible to participate, is that correct?

SENATOR HARTNETT: From the local, they must...

SENATOR VRTISKA: Okay.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Yeah.

SENATOR VRTISKA: The other question I had, I think you partly answered, but I didn't quite get it all. If I belong to my fire department for six years, and then I move to another community, and I'm there two years, then I move to another community, what happens to those...do I have to always start over again and get ten more years in that community?
