SENATOR BROWN: At this point in time there is a previous system that is still being used, called Job 148. That system will be turned off June 1, and the operating system of CHARTS will be...will do it at that point in time,...

SENATOR QUANDAHL: Okay.

SENATOR BROWN: ...all.

SENATOR QUANDAHL: Now are there...are there any...are there any counties at this time that are on the...the CHARTS system?

SENATOR BROWN: Yes, the CHARTS system is doing certain aspects, and Job 148 is still doing certain aspects. As of June 1, it will just be...CHARTS will be doing it all. There's a...CHARTS is the operating system, JUSTICE is the mechanism by...the hardware part of the mechanism by which the information is gathered.

SENATOR QUANDAHL: Okay. And then I guess I do have a follow-up question.

SENATOR BROWN: And so there are...there are counties that are not...

SENATOR COORDSEN: One minute.

SENATOR BROWN: ...on JUSTICE.

SENATOR QUANDAHL: Okay. Is the...is the JUSTICE system, here's the question, is the JUSTICE system up, and is it fully operational at this point?

SENATOR BROWN: There are counties that are not on the JUSTICE system.

SENATOR QUANDAHL: Okay. And, I guess, my question is, is it fully operational at this point, for the counties that are on it?

SENATOR BROWN: For the counties that are on it, yes.
