SENATOR HARTNETT: Is that...

SENATOR JANSSEN: That's with the JUSTICE system. I think that's the one there are 53 counties that are on.

SENATOR HARTNETT: Fifty-three. That's one of your counties, Senator Janssen?

SENATOR JANSSEN: Yes. Well, it's the only county I have, Senator Hartnett. (Laugh)

SENATOR JANSSEN: It's the only...only one I have. But that, you know, and I'm not saying that the system that Douglas County, it's a fine system and it probably does the same thing. The only difference is there are more counties that have this particular system, and I won't argue the fact which one is the best because I certainly don't know. All I know is what...what this county is doing, and in 24 hours from receipt of that payment they have the...the woman and the children have the money. And they also sent me out a form here, if anyone would like to look at it. It came from one of the corporations in Fremont on how they list...they send one check and here is a break down of those people and what the payment is, so they cross-check that with the amount that the check is in order to find out what, you know, to make sure everything balances. And it seems to work fine and I don't see any reason why in the world, if we're getting that information...
