SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: I'm just looking at the language because...

SENATOR BEUTLER: You have a Cash Fund in Section 6, but I wasn't sure what the...

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: It's a different...

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...intent of that was...

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: ...different...

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...and, in fact, that was another one of my questions.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: ...it's a different one. In the A bill, you're going to have to set up a program. It would be similar to other...you'd get a number, a program number, and you'd have to run that money through that program number. You wouldn't have to set up a separate fund, as I understand it, if you do it through the A bill and put out that money. But that's a discussion I probably had two days ago...

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: One minute.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: ...and that was my impression on how that would be handled, because you're going to have to tinker with the A bill.

SENATOR BEUTLER: But the final question would be, and I think I'm just repeating what you said earlier, but it would be your expectation with regard to collection that it would be the state's responsibility to stay on top of the local county attorney to prosecute these.
