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that the designation will be made by the 40 people and the designation shall be subject to confirmation by a majority of the members of the Legislature, so that's change one and I believe that addresses the concerns that several people had. I think that does away with the separation of powers argument. Two, the question was over the study that the Exec Board would oversee as to whether the date was effective. We've taken out the date, but there will be the study to go forward to how we can comply regarding collection disbursement, that we'll select the person or group to conduct the study, but that the study shall not delay implementation of the wage withholding procedures. That, and I'm relying on that has satisfied the federal people, that we're not, with the study, going to use that as a delay tactic, but we're going to use the study as to how best to implement and how we're going to go forward, but we're not going to delay those wage withholding procedures. The other change that is in here that there is an emergency clause added, that there will be rules and regulations adopted to carry this out, and those are the only changes from the original amendment that we've spent the last three hours explaining to you. I believe that, and if I can do this without running into 25 minutes, Senator Brown, you've had a chance to look at this. I'm not asking for complete, unabashed, total attachment...

SENATOR BROWN: Enthusiasm?

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: ...but...

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Brown.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: ...at the present time, Senator Brown, is this an amendment that you're comfortable with, at least moving forward at this point with?

SENATOR BROWN: Yes, I am signed onto it.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You are, that's right. She's a cosigner. You don't get to fall off. I'm sorry. I believe that Senator Jensen, Senator Janssen, Senator Baker, Senator Bohlke, and myself have signed onto this amendment. I would offer this amendment at the present time to put this bill into shape and then I assume there are other members who want to have some
