SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: It would be district courts that are not utilizing, because you have to look at the sentence above, the district courts that aren't utilizing the Statewide Automated Data Processing and Information Retrieval System, in other words, the computer systems. It's...it's the district courts that aren't utilizing...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Well, within the juris...

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: ...that system.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Maybe perhaps this is it: within the jurisdiction of a district court there would only be one county,
