And the sentence that says, "support order payments shall be disbursed within two business days after receipt", because that's in Section 4, that's meant to pertain to the clerks of the district court who are there currently, until such time as the state system takes place. Is that right?

SENATOR BEUTLER: So they have a new requirement upon them here.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Yes.
