beginning with the word "The" in line 5, through the word "section" in line 8, and insert the following new language: "The Title IV-D Division may withhold IV-D funds from any county whose district court is not in compliance with this section."

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Members of the Legislature, what the Clerk read is what I had said, after listening to "Quibbler-I" raise the issue and focus on what it is we're trying to deal with, then the...if Senator...oh, Senator Brashear is not here. I was going to borrow his word colloquy, which was further refined through the colloquy between myself and the Speaker. That's what we have up there. So any questions that would be asked of me, I will answer them. But to make it clear what this amendment is designed to do, it focuses on the court which is not in compliance. And the language in the section preceding that new language talks about the district courts, all district courts shall utilize the Title IV-D Division Statewide Automated Data Processing and Information Retrieval System. That must be done by all the courts. If a court does not do so, the county in which that court is located, will receive no IV-D funds. That is what that amendment will achieve. Thank you, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Discussion on the Chambers amendment? Senator Chambers, you're recognized to close. You're waiving? Senator Chambers waives closing. The question before us is the adoption of the Chambers amendment to AM1775 on LB 637. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Chambers' amendment.
