Legislature. I think we've done good work. And the reason I think it's good work is because we are continuing in faith with a process that has meant that fewer families are on welfare, more children are receiving support, and we are going to have a system that is consistent with the rest of the nation in facilitating that continuing to happen. And the work that we do for children and families is what this is all about. And so I would urge the adoption of AM1775 and the advancement of the bill. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Brown. The question is the adoption of AM1775 to LB 637. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Have you voted? Please record.

CLERK: 39 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Brown's amendment as amended.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is agreed to.

CLERK: Senator Brown, I now have AM1502. But I have a note you wish to withdraw that one, Senator.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Brown.

SENATOR BROWN: Yes, Mr. President, I...I would...

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Senator Beutler, you had provided to me a copy of an amendment to AM1502, but I assume that will go away as well?

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill at this time, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Discussion on the advancement of LB 637? Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 637 to E & R for engrossing.
