SENATOR DIERKS: Yes.

SENATOR BEUTLER: I mean, that seems really kind of impossible.

SENATOR DIERKS: It's my understanding that...my understanding is they would. And it is an added cost to a lot of this on the part of the...on the part of the elevator operators to do all the notification that they're asking for around the area.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Well, that's the end of my questions, Senator. Thank you very much.

SENATOR DIERKS: Okay. Thank you. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Dierks, there are no other lights on, if you'd like to close. He waives closing. The question before the body is the adoption of LR 43. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the advancement...or adoption, excuse me, of LR 43.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The resolution is adopted. We next move to General File. Appropriations bill, LB 816A, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, 816A, by Senator Bohlke. (Read title.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Bohlke, you're recognized to open on LB 816A. Is there anyone authorized to handle the A bill for Senator Bohlke? Senator Wickersham, you're recognized.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Ah...I'm about...

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Wickersham, you can stand at ease.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: I will yield my time to Senator Bohlke.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you. Senator Bohlke, you're recognized to open on LB 816A.
