CLERK: 35 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of committee amendments.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The committee amendments are agreed to. Discussion on the advancement of LB 863? Senator Schrock, you're recognized to close on the advancement of LB 863. Senator Schrock waives closing. The question before us is the advancement of LB 863. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 37 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Schrock's amen...or, I mean, advancement of the bill, excuse me.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is advanced. Mr. Clerk, next item.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 865 was a bill introduced originally by Senator Dwite Pedersen and others. (Read title.) Bill was introduced on January 20, referred to the Judiciary Committee, advanced to General File. I do have committee amendments pending, Mr. President. (AM1566, Legislative Journal page 1939.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Senator Dwite Pedersen, to open on LB 865.

SENATOR DW. PEDERSEN: Thank you, Mr. Lieutenant Governor, members of the Legislature. I would like to relinquish my opening to the Chairman of the Judiciary Committee, as we have some changes on this bill. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Pedersen. Senator Brashear, you're recognized for over nine minutes.
