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you with my experience why, I believe, that the frivolous lawsuits or lawsuits of any kind, because I don't believe some of them are frivolous, but some of them are. They're not all, again, but some are. I want to repeat that. There's two reasons in all the years that I've been working in corrections that I've seen these lawsuits go up. One is we don't have anything for the inmates to do. We don't have jobs. And Senator Bromm said that when he was talking. Basically, he didn't say they didn't have any jobs, but are they just sitting around with nothing else to do. Yes, they are. They're sitting around with nothing else to do. The thing I've been trying more and more and more to bring to your knowledge and I think you all agree is to get...we need to do more, everything we can, to put inmates to work to take up their time, to teach them a work ethic. When they've got nothing else to do, they can read the books, the law books. But there is another reason, and I don't want to bring that in without Corrections being here to defend themselves, but I'll tell you part of it, is the rule book deciphered is about the size of this law book, and the rules come in. We get at least that much change to it every month. And as we write more and more rules and regulations, we have more and more reasons that lawsuits are being thrown in. So there's frivolous on both sides and there's...and that has...that has really, and I could bring that to you in more of a fashion down the road. But I think the study would be good, Senator Bromm, and without an official interim study I would dedicate some of my time to help you in that, in any way, shape or form that I can. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Pedersen. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I'm going to read from the memorandum order of Judge Kopf in the nuclear waste case, but before I do that I want to remind my colleagues, not just Senator Bromm, that inmate rights have been protected through lawsuits brought by inmates. The Attorney General has lost lawsuits brought by inmates. Attorneys General all over the country don't want inmates to be able to bring any lawsuits. Senator Bromm talked about frivolous lawsuits. I'm going to read what Judge Kopf said about your Attorney General. At page 18 of his order he said, quote, in addition to the
