SPEAKER KRISTENSEN PRESIDING

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Debate on the amendment? Senator Brashear.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Mr. Speaker, members of the body, I, too, would join with Senator Landis and urge, for all the good reasons he stated, and I mean the good ones, in terms of established procedure and protocol and comity and working together...that we return this bill, that we take this amendment, and that we go forward. I...and I would have said that if I'd been on the floor or alert at the time that he ran the amendment in the first place. Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Further debate on the motion to return? Senator Landis, there are no further lights; you're recognized to close. He waives closing. The question is, shall we return to Select File for specific amendment AM1796? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The motion to return is successful. Senator Landis, you're recognized to open on AM1796.

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you. I ask for the adoption of the amendment that I've described, which is to strip that provision which we put on on Select File. Senator Brashear had indicated that this is something we should do for comity or comity's sake, and I would agree with that. I'm just not sure that it isn't for comedy's sake that we do this as well.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Debate on adoption of the amendment? Senator Landis waives closing. The question before the body is the adoption of AM1796. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record.
