Administrative Services to reprogram their computers at some extra cost in midterm, and that's the difficulty. SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Debate on the reconsideration motion? Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, when "Wizard Whickenham from Twickenham" speaks, everybody pays close attention. So I think he misspoke when he said it takes 30 votes for the emergency clause. It takes 30 plus 3. And the only reason I'm mentioning it, somebody might come over and when they see 30 votes, they won't come through. I'm supporting, by the way, what the Wizard is suggesting.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Further debate? Senator Wickersham, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Thank you, Senator Chambers, for your correction. I have been here long enough; I should have known how many it took. But hopefully we can find 33. Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You've heard the closing. The question before the body is the motion to reconsider LB 36 with the emergency clause attached. And I will remind the body that the reconsideration motion will take 33 votes as well. All those in favor of reconsideration vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 7 nays to reconsider the Final Reading vote of LB 36 with the emergency clause attached, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The reconsideration motion is successful. All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 36 with the emergency clause attached pass? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed
