CLERK: Third confirmation report this morning by General Affairs Committee, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Janssen, to open on your report.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Madam President, members. The General Affairs Committee desires to report favorably upon Mr. Robert Logsdon. Mr. Logsdon has had a long line of experience in this area. He was the owner of the Goldenrod Restaurant and Bar in Tecumseh, Nebraska, from August, in 1948, to May of 1956, and he was the owner and manager of the Spigot Bar in Lincoln, from August of '56 to August of '58, and he was the owner and co-manager of the State Capitol Cafeteria, here in the Capitol, from 1965 to 1973. And he was the general manager of the Legion Club, here in Lincoln, from August of '58 to January of 1997. He is on the Board of Directors at the Havelock State Bank. He's been...he was there from 1965 to 1982, and with the Nebraska Racing Commission from 1970 to 1973. He was President of the Lincoln Beer Retailers Association in 1957. He's a life member of the American Legion, Veterans of Foreign Wars, Masonic Lodge, Scottish Rite, Shrine, Elks, Sowers, and the Footprinters. He was a...he attended Peru State Teachers College from 1946 to 1948. I had never met Mr. Logsdon before, until the hearing. And I believe his expertise in this area would be very beneficial to the Liquor Control Commission. I ask for your approval of Mr. Logsdon to the Liquor Control Commission.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Janssen. Discussion on the General Affairs confirmation report? Seeing none, Senator Chambers.
