SENATOR RAIKES: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Raikes, do you have a copy of the amendment? My time is going to run out, so if, when you...and I've got my light on, if, when you find it, you will turn to page 4 of the amendment,...

SENATOR CROSBY: Time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...we'll go from there.

SENATOR RAIKES: Okay.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Chambers, your light is next.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Madam President. Senator Raikes, have you found page 4 of the amendment?

SENATOR RAIKES: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: All right. Now, if you look in line 6, that's the beginning of Section 4. Are you with me?

SENATOR RAIKES: We...I'm one line off. In my copy line 5 is the beginning of Section 4, but....

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay.

SENATOR RAIKES: All right.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Any political subdivision that has these four things, either one of these four, acquired, constructed, or operated, or has approved a general obligation bond issue for those purposes. Do you see that language?

SENATOR RAIKES: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And we're talking here about the application. Now that language that says "has approved a general obligation bond issue", does that mean to you that, at the time the application is submitted, the public must have already voted
