SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yeah.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Madam President, I'd like to ask Senator Landis, in view of the discussion he had, could we continue this, because this...this is legitimate, Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: Um-huh.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I'm not just trying to take time.

SENATOR LANDIS: Okay.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I'm actually trying to engage in substantive discussion. Now let's get to the point where some new tax revenue has been generated, so we have something in this fund.
