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SENATOR LANDIS: ...and I'll get back up and give my best answer.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Page 2, it would be subsection (3) of Section 3, in the definition of bond.

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay.

SENATOR LANDIS: I'm going to sit down and think about that for a moment, and I'll try to give you an answer.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank...

SENATOR LANDIS: I will tell you, Senator Chambers, I had my light on briefly, because I thought you were having an exchange with Senator Raikes, and it was reported to me, by Mr. Kilpatrick, about employment....

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Um-huh.

SENATOR LANDIS: ...and attributable revenue, and since Senator Raikes is a no vote on the bill, he's not exactly the appropriate person to figure out what the intent of the language is, since he doesn't support it.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: But he was the only one I could talk to at that time, so...

SENATOR LANDIS: Right, I know that happened, that's why I had my light on. I bet we'll have a chance to talk.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay, good. And when we do, then any of the areas that I've raised, you can feel free to comment on, because I may forget to raise them individually, farther down the line. Madam President, members of the Legislature, the reason I...

SENATOR CROSBY: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...the reason I want to go into substantive
