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SENATOR WEHRBEIN: It might be important to say here, since you said that, and to reiterate it because sometimes we run into this, it...your intention that the Legislature in a sense is approving what this board has done when it appropriates that fund out of that cash fund; that it is not intended to play games with; that it's simply, in a sense, oversight or certification that what the board said is accurate and that the board...it would be the intent of the Legislature to go ahead, appropriate that money as it accumulates in there, and that it's understood that this is over a period of time, that those entities that are requesting this money or are entitled to this money will have to wait in their own due course as that money comes in, is certified and appropriated by the Legislature. It would not be the intent to have special sessions or any...any such action for that type of activity.

SENATOR LANDIS: And, by the way, you'll notice that we have an intense statement here saying we intend to do this, but, as Senator Chambers has indicated, in fact we are a Legislature, we can't bind each other, but your statement on the record right there, which I think was as accurately put as I could imagine, would speak, from my estimation over the next 20 years, because those are the rules. That's what you're saying. We're saying that we're not...this is not meant to be a way of pressuring Omaha to do something, (inaudible) withhold it. We are ministers. We have control, but we're basically saying now, look, if we play by the up and up, this money comes in, we intend to give it back to you up to 75 million bucks, and not make this some kind of new political intrigue or pressure system tied to anything else. We're supposed to play it straight.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Okay. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. Senator Chambers, there are no further lights on, so you're recognized to close on your motion to reconsider.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Mr. President, members of the Legislature, what I was about to say when I ran out of time on the last speaking occasion was that the members should pay attention to this despite the fact that I am assuming more
