they make here might sell well, but when we get out into the wider community and they say, well, we didn't say anything because we'd a been helping Ernie filibuster, and some people are going to say, well, you should have explained the bill anyway; you should have told why you supported it while there was debate, no matter how you characterized it. I guess Senator Landis is filibustering. Senator Raikes is filibustering. Senator Coordsen, who answered questions, is filibustering. I believe even Senator Wickersham has answered questions. He's filibustering. Senator Vrtiska is filibustering and Senator Wehrbein's filibustering. That shows how lacking in connection some of my colleagues are with what happens on this floor. Senator Bruning not only doesn't understand this bill. He doesn't even understand what has been happening here. And I do take offense, I do. Now it's silly for him to say something like that and his silliness is not going to go uncommented on by me, and he can respond to me. He's on the floor. He's a senator. He's a grown man. He's a daddy now. I'm sure his children don't want to look back and say, my daddy made silly statements and then didn't debate on the floor. So, since he threw out the challenge, let him carry through on it. But I'm still going to do as I said that I would do. Many times we have distractions along the way, but we can never forget our main purpose, and my purpose is to go through this bill and point out some of the problems in it. And who knows what might happen by this afternoon. Maybe Senator Landis will be in a position to substitute his amendment or amendments for some of those that I have up there. I'm a reasonable man,...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...but I'm not going to be reasonable when other people are unreasonable. And if somebody thinks they can slap me down and get away with it, they got another thing coming. My children wouldn't respect their daddy if he took that, nor would my grandchildren respect their granddaddy if he took that. And I'll be here after they're all gone. I have touched on what constitutes a convention and meeting center facility with emphasis on that attached parking garage. I want to touch on that just a bit more next time.
