SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you, Senator Wickersham.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Bruning, on the Chambers amendment.

SENATOR BRUNING: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I couldn't help but take the opportunity to correct my misguided colleague that sits next to me, Senator Tyson, and his reference to the College World Series or, more specifically, to Rosenblatt Stadium and how it was a drain on taxpayers' money. And, Senator Tyson, am I safe to say that you've never been to the College World Series or to Rosenblatt Stadium? Okay. So Senator Tyson is speaking of that, that he has no experience, which is...which is not necessarily surprising. But I wanted to say that the College World Series, specifically June 11th through the 19th...

SENATOR TYSON: (Away from microphone.) I didn't mention the College World Series.

SENATOR BRUNING: Well, no, but I will, because that's one of the reasons the city has spent...has spent money on Rosenblatt Stadium. Every year, from June 11th through the 19th this year, thousands and thousands of people come in from out of state and spend their money in our city. If you take the opportunity to go to the College World Series, you'll see what this type of money will do, and it's not unlike what the convention center will do. Rosenblatt Stadium has been expanded by the city. It is a...it is a shining jewel in that part of town. I'll yield my time in a moment to Senator Hilgert, but every year thousands of people come in and enjoy the College World Series at Rosenblatt Stadium. It's a perfect example of how tax money can be used to bring in revenue from outside the state. You go through the...you go through the parking lot and you'll see license plate after license plate from Louisiana, Arizona. These people come in and they frequent the bars and the
