the soil acceptable for use. But those are things that haven't been discussed either. Those are things that will cost money. And the reason I want my rural colleagues to pay attention, the Governor incorrectly said that no tax...no state tax money will be involved in this. He was quoted in the paper as saying that. But according to the fiscal note it says the following: This bill could increase General Fund expenditures. The amount of the increase would depend on the number of cities that qualify for state assistance under the provisions of this bill. In other words, whenever money that would go into the state General Fund goes someplace else, that is tax money subtracted from what the state has to use, wherever it comes from. State money will go into this if the project works as it is envisioned, and I think the more discussion that occurs the more questions will be raised. The next time around, I won't do it on my reconsideration motion, I have a series of questions I would like to explore with Senator Landis relative to these participants and, maybe to his shock and amazement, what I would suggest would be, I think, in keeping with what he described as his intent about the word. And, Senator Landis, just to kind of give you a general overview, and then I'll go to specific areas in the bill where I would think somebody would want to offer an amendment, to cross the threshold to allow an event to be considered for attributable income, you must have at least 50 percent of people from outside of Nebraska. Then it was your understanding, based on our discussion, that all participants from that point on, including those within Nebraska, would be counted as attributable income. Just so you can look for these points, these locations, I would say at page 2, line 10, after the word "buy", I would insert "all". Then, in page 3, line 8, after "buy", I would insert, if I were doing this, "all". Then page 3, line 20, I would strike that semicolon, and let me get it right, and I would insert "plus all other participants who attend." And you'll have a chance to look at that so that when we do get a chance to discuss it then you can tell me what you think about that. Members of the Legislature, since I was not at the Revenue Committee hearing...
