

TRANSCRIPT PREPARED BY THE CLERK OF THE LEGISLATURE
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LB 382

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The motion is not accepted. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator Chambers would move to amend with FA159.
(Legislative Journal page 1804.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Chambers, you're recognized to open
on FA159.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President and members of the Legislature,
my gadget is failing me. I'm about to...the time can be
running. Mr. President, members of the Legislature, now I can
discuss the one that I incorrectly discussed on the last vote.
This is the one on page 1, line 13, where we will change the
position of the word "will" and I hope that we will do this, but
perhaps we shall not. Who knows? But it gives the opportunity
to continue discussing the bill. On page 2 of the amendment, in
subsection (4), I was making the observation that there is
restrictive language in this statute relative to the use that
can be made of this parking facility. I'm going to ask Senator
Coordsen a question, if he is willing to answer.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Coordsen.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Only, Senator Chambers, if it's really simply
and has one syllable words in it, but we'll try.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: You put me in a bind. I'm going to see what
I can do. Now your name and your title can't be...can't
restrict me to one. Okay, Sen. Cord, I would like to ask you
this.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: On page 2, in subsec. (4) of Sec. 3.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Now we are speaking on the committee
amendments, AM1377?
